



## Privacy and Security Statement

This statement sets out this Site's policies relating to the privacy and security of your "personal information" and security of your other information. This privacy and security statement applies only to this Site.

This Site is operated in compliance with the Government of Victoria's Information Privacy Principles ("IPP's"), a copy of which can be obtained at: <http://www.privacy.vic.gov.au/dir100/priweb.nsf/content/A4808C49ACF59366CA256C4D0018C5C6>

This Site collects and uses the following information from users:

1. A record of your visit and logs the following information for statistical purposes - the user's IP address, the date and time of the visit to the Site, the pages accessed and documents downloaded, the previous website visited and the type of browser used. No attempt will be made to identify users or their browsing activities except, in the unlikely event of an investigation, where a law enforcement agency may exercise a warrant to inspect our service provider's logs. This information is analysed at the end of each month to determine the Site's usage statistics.
2. The Site retains the e-mail address of people who send E-mails through the "Contact Us" facility, for the purpose of sending a response. They are stored in a secure area and will not be used for any other purpose, nor disclosed without your consent.
3. If you seek to submit websites for addition to the Links area on this Site, you are asked to supply information about your organisation, its location and web site details and your contact details.
4. Such information may or may not be "personal information" for the purpose of the IPP's. Nonetheless, you consent to the use of this information to establish ownership of the material and to enable Site's administrators to contact website administrators/content owners, to confirm (or not) the website registration and advise them of the link being published on this Site. The information is then kept for contact purposes in the course of monitoring site currency. The information is stored in a secure area of the Site's system.
5. Your personal information will not be disclosed to a third party except in accordance with the IPP's.
6. Site administrators are required to protect and handle your "personal information" in accordance with the IPP's.
7. You should note that there are inherent risks associated with transmission of information via the Internet. You should make your own assessment of the potential risks to the

security of your information when making a decision as to whether or not you should utilise this Site. There are alternative ways of obtaining information for those who do not wish to use the Internet.
